



COMMITTEE MEETING - 25 FEBRUARY 2014

1. Apologies

Apologies were received from Graham Bennett.

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting

Agreed as accurate.

ACTION: Freya to post on Big Tent for all members to view.

3. Approval of Sub-group for 2014 Regatta

Agreed to establish a core sub-group to form the regatta committee. Shaun volunteered to be the point of contact between the committee and sub-committee. Other members previously noting interest are Gaynor, Fiona, Gillian, Jennifer.

Jennifer confirmed that the Honest Toun Association has indicated that we could hold a regatta on Sunday 27 July 2014. Whilst there are no restriction on the time which the skiff regatta is held, the sub-group should take account of other Musselburgh Festival events happening on the same day:

- Harbour Ceremony at 3pm – fishing boat will leave the harbour at 3pm.
- The raft race will take place between 1330 and 1530.

It was suggested that the Regatta Sub-group will also consider invitations received to attend regattas at other clubs.

4. Funding Applications

Gaynor and Fiona previously agreed to draft funding applications to propose to the committee and Gaynor will be the main point of contact for the committee regarding funding applications. Items on a wish list were discussed:

- **Flares (High)**
Chemical smoke flares in a waterproof container are £49.
- **Oars £1200 (High)**
Ronnie advised he would build new oars – approx. £50 - £80/oar. The cost of this can be met from existing funds however we need another set of oars which will be requested in part of a funding application.
- **Storage container**
A container, possibly under the coxswain seat, which can be used to store items and be removable from the boat.
- **Radio** waterproof £150
- **Megaphone** (waterproof £300)
- **Training**

- VHF Radio – training for two people (avg £150pp)
- Coxswain

- **New skiff!**
Details of up to date costs will be obtained from Jordan Boats/Scottish Coastal Rowing.
